WARMING UP

1. Who are some of the groups of people that represent our social strata here in Canada or in Barrie? Is everyone welcome at Harvest and in my small group?

DIGGING IN

2. *5 Things*: “If I want to be like Jesus, I cannot be concerned with what the prevailing culture says about how we ought to live and must only be concerned with what Jesus says about how we ought to live.” What is a “prevailing culture” issue that I personally have to deal with if I am going to live for Jesus? Why is money such a sticking point for us?
3. *4 Things*: What character trait exemplified by John the Baptist most intrigues me? (His sense of his relationship to Jesus, his clear sense of purpose, or his absolute commitment.) Which of these do I need to pay attention to in my own walk with Christ right now?
4. *3 Things*: Have I embraced the gospel? Do I believe the gospel is for everyone, or am I holding back from sharing with a particular person?
5. Pastor Todd said, “Faith produces repentance and brings forgiveness that then manifests itself in righteous living.” Discuss why that order is crucial to understand.
6. *2 Things*: Jesus is Saviour and judge! How does the concept of hell and judgment affect me? Am I convinced of coming judgment but “soft” on the reality of hell in how I live or witness? How does living with the reality of hell change my daily life?
