FIVE behaviours that I will show when I'm a truly repentant person  
(3:10-14)

1. I ask what I need to do after hearing the Word preached
2. I meet the needs of others and not myself
3. I challenge cultural norms in how I choose to live
4. I respond outwardly as a result of real heart change
5. I pay the price...*literally*

FOUR reasons why I should give John the Baptist my close attention  
(3:15-18)

1. He had a strong "sense of his overwhelming unworthiness"
2. He never lost sight of who he was working for
3. He accepted God's path for him no matter how painful it would be
4. He didn't quit his job until it was impossible for him to continue

THREE points I need to grasp about the Word John preached  
(3:10-14, 19-20)

1. Good works flow out of genuine repentance and do not earn us forgiveness from God
2. The good news of Jesus Christ is for everyone
3. There will always be those who find the message compelling and others who find it threatening

TWO truths about Jesus that I should see in what was preached  
(3:16b-17)

1. He gathers the repentant to himself
2. He sends the unrepentant away from himself for eternity

ONE thing that we cannot ignore (3:10-14, 19-20)
