Dig In

5 Snapshots of God's love:

When I was dead, he revived me. (Ephesians 2:4-5)

- What are some areas of your life that were spiritually dead but are now clearly revived since you've come to Jesus?
- Why is spiritual revival the necessary foundational step in salvation and discipleship?

When I'm hurting, he comforts me. (2 Corinthians 1:3-5)

- What does it mean to say that "Sometimes God calms the storm and sometimes he comforts the child?"
- How do you most often feel comforted by God? Is it by his people, His word, or both?

When I'm uncertain, he guides me. (Proverbs 3:5-6)

- What are some practical ways to bring our uncertainty to the Lord so that we receive his guidance?
- How does God confirm the way for us to go?

When I disobey, he disciplines me. (Hebrews 12:5-11)

- How does submitting to God's discipline in our lives lead us to greater fruitfulness?
- As you consider your personal growth, what has God's discipline trained you to do better than you did before?

When I repent, he welcomes me. (Luke 15:11-24)

- What is your greatest fear about coming back to God after you've completely blown the relationship with him?
- How does this passage refute your fears?
