### ***Open Up***

*How would you feel if a significant, celebrated person acknowledge you from among the crowd and invited himself to dinner in your home?*

### ***Dig In***

**Can you answer “yes” to all of these questions from the sermon: Has salvation come to your house? Do I have a whatever-it-takes attitude about getting it? Do I have joy in hearing what Jesus says to me? Do I see big changes happening in my life?**

- Why do you think Luke included Zacchaeus’ story in his gospel?
- Romans 8:28-30 explains how Jesus knew Zacchaeus’ name. When it comes to our pride, why does it matter that Jesus knows about us before we even want to know about him?
- The crowd determined that Zacchaeus’ lifestyle deemed him unworthy of Jesus’ attention but Jesus went to his house anyway. What goes on in your house that you think could (but doesn’t) keep Jesus away?
- Jesus brought salvation to a sinner’s house. What would you list as evidence of salvation coming to your sinful home? (Does this reference to your home being sinful make you uncomfortable?)
- As you read through Colossians 3:1-25 which instructions push you toward new behaviour?
- In light of the above question, how are you working hard to make salvation ever more evident in your home?
- Zacchaeus had a radical response to Jesus’ presence in his life. Are there any further radical responses you’d like to give to Jesus?
- Does the way you live in your house declare that you have found the joy of salvation?

### ***Break Out***

*Salvation is the point of the Gospel message. Often, we get focused on what we need to change but let’s focus on what we can do to celebrate. How can you lead your home to experience the joy of your salvation this week?*
