


THE PROVISION OF THE CHRIST

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Jordan gave us an illustration of compartmentalized faith. Are there segments of your life that are more or less connected with the Spirit? Why does a boxed approach to Christianity interfere with the mission of the gospel?
2. Read 1 Corinthians 3:16. What does it mean to say that we all collectively are God's temple? Does knowing that you have the Holy Spirit in common affect your relationships with people in your church? How so?
3. Read 1 Corinthians 6:19. What does it mean to say that you as an individual are a temple of the Holy Spirit? What physical actions support your spiritual devotion to Jesus Christ?
4. Are you serving gladly? If not, what would help you experience more joy in what you do for Christ?

5. Why is it vital for you to be connected relationally? If you are not connected, who can you let into your life so you can grow together?

6. Are you ready to welcome others in? In the instances where you are not, what will help you overcome your hesitations? *(Have you drawn lines of exclusion that grieve God?)*

7. How do you become easier to disagree with? When disagreements are intense, what does the Holy Spirit lead you to do?

8. Life with the Holy Spirit is a miraculous reality the brings us closer to God and others who serve him. What's maturing in you as you get closer to God and connect with more people who believe? *(Look at 2 Peter 1:5-8, Galatians 5:22-23, Colossians 3:12-17 for indicators of what the Spirit develops in our lives.)*
