DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What experiences and details set you apart from the crowd? What's something about you that helps makes you a unique person?
2. Would you be closer to 24,000 or 60,000 thoughts a day? Do negative thoughts about your identity or value or performance creep and get repeated? Which verse(s) of this Psalm are going to help you if you think about them more often?
3. Could you be a moody individual? Is it hard for you to express yourself emotionally? Why might it be easier or harder for you to share your emotions with others?
4. Can you relate to the idea of being hemmed in by God? (v.5) Does this make you feel restricted or protected? How does God help you by placing you in pocket of intimate care?
5. Are you concerned about a situation in your life where God seems to have left you alone? Can you identify any signs of his presence in that situation? How can you worship him in hope?
