GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Are you uncomfortable being called a disciple of Christ? What are some ways that 'disciple' conveys a more intense commitment to Jesus than 'believer' or 'church goer'?
2. Have you ever wondered if the Great Commission applies equally to every Christian? What indicates that the command was for the disciples? On the other hand, what supports the conclusion that the command is for the church?
3. If your purpose doesn't include putting effort into making disciples, what is your Christian life accomplishing for God? (*Note: emphasis is on effort, i.e., disciple making not result! i.e., counting the disciples.*)
4. **Worship:** What parts your daily life count as genuine heart driven worship? What mundane or routine activities could be approached as worship? (How would you make the change?)

5. **Walk:** Many people (would) love to be part of a life-changing small group or ministry team. What are some of the advantages gained? What do you give up while part of a small group?

6. **Work:** How do you desire to serve others with your talents and spiritual gifts? What's one serving barrier that you'll need help to overcome?

7. **Witness:** Do we all have the same opportunities to be witness? If someone asked you to testify about Jesus' identity, who would you say he is? What experience led you to this conclusion?
