VARIOUS SCRIPTURES

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We value and prioritize four pillars...

- ***Unapologetic preaching – Proclaiming the authority of God’s Word without apology (2 Tim 4:2)***
- ***Unashamed adoration – Lifting high the name of Jesus in worship (John 4:24)***
- ***Unceasing prayer – Believing firmly in the power of prayer (Eph 6:18)***
- ***Unafraid witness – Sharing the good news of Jesus with boldness (Eph 6:19-20)***

GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Does your family operate by any foundational biblical principles? How are these communicated? *(Artwork, coffee mugs, email taglines, etc.)*
2. Have you considered personal bible study as the primary way to establish shared values with God? How might spending more time in the word affect your connection with God?
3. 2 Timothy 4:3-4 anticipates a time when people will not endure “sound teaching” but prefer teachers with messages that suit their “itching ears”. Does this appear to be happening now? How do you react to a spiritual message that is difficult to support with scripture?
4. How do you feel about what God has done for you? Give examples of what you want unashamed worship to look like in response to his work and presence. *(Think about why John 4:24 leads us to worship in spirit and truth rather than simply bringing our bodies to the right place at the correct time.)*

5. Following the direction of Ephesians 6:18 describe ways of engaging in meaningful prayer more often than you do now? What might God want you to pray about as a weekly or daily ministry? (It could be a relationship, a ministry, a situation that needs a good outcome, etc.)

6. Do you think fear prevents you from sharing the gospel more than you already do? If God gave you the gift of boldness, who would you talk to about the Gospel?

7. Are any of the four pillars in need of critical attention in your personal life? What role do you want believers to play as you attempt to strengthen this area?
