3. What does Paul want us to understand when he says, "...put no confidence in the flesh"?
4. How is your joy affected when you're working to be considered righteous?
5. What will it mean for you to seek the righteousness that comes by faith in Jesus Christ? (Is there a privilege you will need to deny? Are there influence opportunities that you'll have to walk away from? Is there an achievement that you'll have to re-evaluate?)
