

# GREAT FEAR FELL

*As a witness of Jesus, I know that there is a dividing line between those who are inside and those who are outside of God's kingdom (11:1-2)...and the Holy Spirit has empowered me to appeal to those outside to turn to Christ (11:3-6)...fully aware that I will be fiercely opposed by those who despise the gospel (11:7-10)...but also, that God, in the end, will bring about the conversion of many for his own glory (11:11-14)*

## GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Have you ever been called to serve as a witness on a person's behalf? How does this witnessing compare to being a witness of Jesus?
2. **John was asked to "Rise and measure the temple of God, the altar, and those who worship there, but do not measure the court outside the temple..." John measures what belongs to the Kingdom of God. Some people will be in, and others will be out.** What's the potential difference between the hearts of people at the altar and those in the temple courts?
3. **The witness's received authority and power to challenge the people and turn them toward God. They have remarkable, miraculous power which can be used to help bring their audience to humility. Jesus entered the Temple and overturned tables. He made God's will more evident by appealing to his people to return to God.** How can you take the authority and power you have and redirect people toward obedience to God?
4. **Have you experienced people who are fiercely opposed to the Gospel?** How did you respond to their hostility?
5. What do you think is the significance of the witnesses receiving the breath of life (v. 11) after they had died? How does knowing that witnesses had supernatural protection encourage believers who are facing persecution?
