***When God, in his sovereignty, says, “It is done!” (16:17), I will see his terrible wrath poured out on the earth (16:1-4), hear the angels proclaim his perfect justice (16:5-7), witness the folly of those who refuse to repent (16:8-11, 18-21), and prepare myself for Jesus’ imminent arrival (16:12-16).***

## GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. The consequences for rebelling against God are severe. Revelation 16:6 says that the people “deserve” the wrath they experience. Revelation 16:7 says God’s judgements are just and true. Why are these people incurring God’s wrath?
2. God’s wrath is symbolically divided into seven bowls. Each bowl targets a different part of rebellious life. List each bowl’s number and who or what it affects.
