GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. ***Have you ever thought about why sermons receive their titles?*** What other titles (based on verses) would be appropriate as themes for this chapter?
2. ***We see Jesus in a completely different way than he appears in the gospels. If he seemed friendly to sinners there, he's terrifying here. He is shown as the warrior king bent on conquering his enemies.*** Why do believers need to see Jesus like this? What message of hope is reinforced with such vivid battlefield imagery?
3. ***Jesus is faithful and true, and he is the Word of God. John 1 is another text that describes Jesus as the Word of God. Such passages are essential to understanding Jesus as part of the Godhead. Jesus is not a lesser form of God, but one in essence with the Father and Spirit, equal in person, worthy of worship, and undefeatable in battle. Any headway evil seems to make in this world against his name will be undone with one word from Jesus' mouth when he returns!*** Is your mental image of Jesus adequate without meditating on him as a victorious warrior? What influence does the chapter have on your daily hopes and activity? How would it help you in the face of vicious persecution or a Satanic attack?
4. Whom do you know that is lost on a sinful path and is in danger of meeting Jesus on the White Horse? What is a new way to reach out to them with love and a warning of what's to come?
