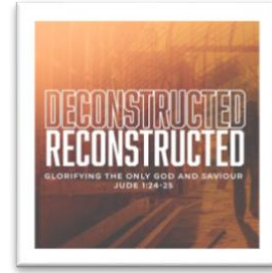


Glorifying the only God and Saviour

GROUP STUDY QUESTIONS

1) Read Jude 1:24.

- Who ultimately is the one who sustains us in our faith? Us or God? Who ultimately determines whether we persevere or not?
- Have you ever had to address someone who had been influenced by false teachings? How did it go? How can we steer someone in the right direction after they've been misled?

2) Read Romans 8:30.

- what does Paul intend to teach but all those in the golden link (predestined, called, justified, glorified)? Can anyone be lost?
- How does it change our view on others to know that we will **all** be glorified in Christ? How might this change the way we treat them?

3) Jesus Christ is the only name by which we may be saved, and the only one who can bring us true contentment and joy.

- What "gods" do we tend to worship in our modern culture? How do these subtly pull us away from the one true God?
- Our culture pushes these gods onto us constantly through media, social pressures, and entertainment. How have you experienced this form of influence? How can we protect younger and more impressionable believers from this?

4) Pastor Todd said "The challenge is that many who are deconstructing are doing so because they want to call their own shots. They want little to no Jesus, and much more of self. They don't want to submit to his authority as revealed in His Word."

- In what ways do you struggle to submit to Christ's authority? How might He be calling you to submit now?
- How can we be confident knowing God is sovereign over all things? How might this prevent us from falling to the world, and deconstructing our faith?

5) As the series comes to a close, discuss how it has impacted you these last few weeks. Pray that God may continue to reveal to us the depth of His character and His glory, and that we may be led to deeper devotion in response.
